CPN TAKES ANOTHER STEP INTO THE DIGITAL WORLD

Starting with this issue of CPN, you will notice web links on most but not all articles in the form: <https://doi.org/10.55360/cpn512.br397>. This web link is a permanent link via a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) to the digital version of Barry Rice's *Triantha occidentalis* article in this issue. Entering that link into a web browser will take you to a virtual page on the cpn.carnivorousplants.org website that will display information on the article and after the six-month embargo, offer a link to download the PDF of the article.

Having a permanent DOI web link to the CPN website is convenient but that is not the main reason we are doing this. When we register a digital object such as an article PDF, we do much more than give a link to a page with a link to the PDF. We upload information about the contents of the article including the reference list with the DOIs of all articles that have DOIs. This is done as a service to the author because it increases the visibility of the article as well as CPN and the ICPS. Ultimately, we hope this step will increase the number of authors willing to publish scholarly articles of interest to members and the scientific community in CPN.
