Werkgroep Carnivora will host the ICPS Conference 2026 at Hortus Botanicus, Leiden, The Netherlands, 21-23 August 2026 plus excursions on 24-26 August.

From Friday through Sunday, we have three days of lectures. We've put together a diverse program of travel reports, conservation programs, scientific studies, research, and new species descriptions. Alongside the classic lecture format, we added an interactive session on Saturday afternoon with plenty of room for discussion and your own ideas in themed sessions and a forum. You can continue those discussions during a cozy evening at the conference dinner. After the conference, from Monday to Wednesday, there are three days of excursions visiting various nurseries and gardens.

The Netherlands and Leiden are easy to reach. By plane, Schiphol Amsterdam is the most convenient. Other airports can be cheaper but are farther away. From Schiphol, take the train to Leiden in 15 minutes. From Leiden Central Station, it's a 20-minute walk to the Hortus Botanicus at Rapenburg 73. By car, park cheaply at Parking Haagweg with a free shuttle to the garden. Most Dutch people speak English well, so feel free to ask for directions.
